Amend CSSB 1588 (house committee report) as follows:

- (1) In SECTION 10 of the bill, add the following appropriately numbered subdivision to that SECTION and renumber the subsequent subdivisions of that SECTION accordingly:
- (\_\_\_\_) the emergency radio infrastructure account created by HB 442 or similar legislation;
- (2) In SECTION 11 of the bill, add the following appropriately numbered subdivision to that SECTION and renumber the subsequent subdivisions of that SECTION accordingly:
- (\_\_\_\_\_) the dedication of the revenue generated under HB 442, or similar legislation, for the purpose of creating an interoperable statewide emergency radio infrastructure;
- (3) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:
- SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. TRANSFER OF CERTAIN FUNDS. (a) The comptroller shall hold the revenue that under Section 133.102(e)(11), Local Government Code, would be deposited to the credit of the fugitive apprehension account until the effective date of HB 442, Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, or similar legislation creating the emergency radio infrastructure account, and deposit that revenue into the emergency radio infrastructure account on that date.
- (b) If HB 442, Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, or similar legislation creating the emergency radio infrastructure account is not enacted, this section has no effect.
