- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Except as provided by Section 662.010, and
- 8 notwithstanding Section 659.015 or another law, a state employee
- 9 who is a peace officer commissioned by a state officer or state
- 10 agency listed under Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, or
- 11 who is employed by the Department of Public Safety either to perform
- 12 communications or dispatch services related to traffic law
- 13 enforcement or as a public security officer, as that term is defined
- 14 by Section 1701.001, Occupations Code, or who is employed by the
- 15 Parks and Wildlife Department to perform communications and
- 16 dispatch services to assist law enforcement officers commissioned
- 17 by the Parks and Wildlife Commission in performing law enforcement
- 18 <u>duties</u>, and who is required to work on a national or state holiday
- 19 that falls on a Saturday or Sunday is entitled to compensatory time
- 20 off at the rate of one hour for each hour worked on the holiday.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
