8	Sec. 33.093. PHYSICAL EXAMINATION REQUIRED FOR
9	PARTICIPATION IN CERTAIN EXTRACURRICULAR ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES. (a)
10	A student may not participate in an extracurricular athletic
11	activity involving physical contact among the players, including an
12	athletic practice, scrimmage, game, or match for such an activity,
13	sponsored or sanctioned by the University Interscholastic League
14	unless the student has submitted to the school district in which the
15	student attends school a completed form indicating that the student
16	has received a physical examination, including a cognitive
17	assessment.
18	(b) A student must submit a form under this section for each
19	school year in which the student participates in an extracurricular
20	athletic activity to which this section applies.
21	(c) The University Interscholastic League shall adopt rules
