A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to compensation and employment benefits for members of the

- 3 state military forces called to state active duty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 431.082, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) A member of the state military forces called to state
- 8 active duty is a temporary state employee while on state active
- 9 duty. If the length of state active duty for a member of the state
- 10 military forces called to state active duty exceeds 45 consecutive
- 11 days, the adjutant general may pay the member an amount not to
- 12 exceed 165 percent of the amount authorized by the General
- 13 Appropriations Act. If the length of state active duty for a member
- 14 of the state military forces called to state active duty exceeds 90
- 15 consecutive days, the member is after the 90th day eligible for
- 16 coverage in the group benefits program, eligible for membership in
- 17 the employee class of the Employees Retirement System of Texas, and
- 18 otherwise eligible to receive benefits provided to state employees
- 19 whose employment may be temporary.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
