Sections (c), and 7 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows: (b) An applicant for a license under Subsection (a) must be 8 9 15 years and 180 days of age or older and must: (1) have passed a driver education course approved by 10 11 the Texas Education Agency and conducted by a licensed driver 12 education school [department, which may be a course approved under Section 521.205]; and 13 14 (2) pass the examination required by Section 521.161. 15 (c) To be eligible to take the driver education [training] course, the person must be at least 15 [14] years of age. 16 In the manner provided by Subchapter N, the department 17 (f) shall [may] suspend a license issued under this section if the 18 holder of the license is convicted of a moving violation. 19 SECTION 3. Section 521.223(d), Transportation Code, 20 is 21 repealed. 22 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only 23 to the issuance of a hardship license on or after the effective date 24 of this Act. The issuance of a hardship license before the

1 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect 2 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is 3 continued in effect for that purpose.
