1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the extent of extraterritorial jurisdiction for certain
1-10 municipalities.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 42.021, Local Government Code, is
1-13 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-14 (c) Regardless of Subsection (a), the extraterritorial
1-15 jurisdiction of a municipality is the unincorporated area that is
1-16 contiguous to the corporate boundaries of the municipality and that
1-17 is located within three miles of those boundaries if the
1-18 municipality:

1-19 (1) has a population of not less than 20,000 or more
1-20 than 29,000; and

1-21 (2) is located in a county that has a population of
1-22 45,000 or more and borders the Trinity River.

1-23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
