17	(D) that is adjacent to a county described by
18	Paragraph (C) and:
19	(i) has a population of not more than 50,000
20	and contains a municipality with a population of at least 20,000; or
21	(ii) contains, wholly or partly, two or
22	more municipalities with a population of 250,000 or more.
23	SECTION 2. Section 234.032, Local Government Code, is

This subchapter applies only in the unincorporated area of a county if the county: 2 3 (1) contains two or more municipalities with а population of 250,000 or more; [or] 4 5 (2) is a county adjacent to a county described by 6 Subdivision (1); or 7 (3) is a county adjacent to a county described by Subdivision (2) and: 8 9 (A) has a population of not more than 50,000 and contains a municipality with a population of at least 20,000; or 10 11 (B) contains, wholly or partly, two or more municipalities with a population of 250,000 or more. 12 13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
