- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.051, Education Code, is amended to

- 7 Sec. 21.051. <u>RULES REGARDING FIELD EXPERIENCE AND OPTIONS</u>
- 8 FOR FIELD EXPERIENCE AND INTERNSHIPS. (a) In this section,
- 9 "teacher of record" means a person employed by a school district who
- 10 teaches the majority of the instructional day in an academic
- 11 instructional setting and is responsible for evaluating student
- 12 <u>achievement and assigning grades.</u>
- 13 (b) Before a school district may employ a candidate for
- 14 certification as a teacher of record, the candidate must complete
- 15 at least 15 hours of field experience in which the candidate is
- 16 physically present in a classroom instructing students at:
- 17 (1) a campus assigned an acceptable performance rating
- 18 <u>in a school district assigned an accredited status as provided by</u>
- 19 Subchapter C, Chapter 39; or
- 20 (2) a private school recognized for the purpose by the
- 21 agency.
- (c) The board shall propose rules relating to the field
- 23 <u>experience required by Subsection (b). The commissioner by rule</u>
- 24 shall adopt procedures and standards for recognizing a private

- 1 <u>school under Subsection (b)(2).</u>
- 2 (d) The board shall propose rules providing flexible
- 3 options for persons for any field experience or internship required
- 4 for certification.
- 5 SECTION 2. On or before January 1, 2012, the State Board for
- 6 Educator Certification shall propose rules and the Texas Education
- 7 Agency shall adopt rules relating to educator certification as
- 8 prescribed by Section 21.051, Education Code, as amended by this
- 9 Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
