A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the transportation of certain mental health patients.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 574.045, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to
- 6 read as follows:

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- 7 (a) The court may authorize, in the following order of
- 8 priority, the transportation of a committed patient or a patient
- 9 detained under Section 573.022 or 574.023 to the designated mental
- 10 health facility by:
- 11 (1) a special officer for mental health assignment
- 12 <u>certified under Section 1701.404, Occupations Code</u> [a relative or
- 13 other responsible person who has a proper interest in the patient's
- 14 welfare and who receives no remuneration, except for actual and
- 15 necessary expenses];
- 16 (2) the facility administrator of the designated
- 17 mental health facility, unless [if] the administrator notifies the
- 18 court that facility personnel are $\underline{\text{not}}$ available to transport the
- 19 patient;
- 20 (3) [a special officer for mental health assignment
- 21 certified under Section 1701.404, Occupations Code;
- $[\frac{(4)}{2}]$ a representative of the local mental health
- 23 authority, who shall be reimbursed by the county;
- 24 (4) a qualified transportation service provider

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- 1 selected from the list established and maintained as required by
- 2 Section 574.0455 by the commissioners court of the county in which
- 3 the court authorizing the transportation is located; or
- 4 (5) the sheriff or constable $[\tau]$ if no person is
- 5 available under Subdivision (1), (2), (3), or (4)].
- 6 (a-1) A person who under Subsection (a)(1), (2), (3), or (5)
- 7 is authorized by the court to transport a person to a mental health
- 8 facility may contract with a qualified transportation service
- 9 provider that is included on the list established and maintained as
- 10 required by Section 574.0455 by the commissioners court of the
- 11 county in which the court is located to provide the transportation
- 12 authorized by the court.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 574, Health and Safety
- 14 Code, is amended by adding Section 574.0455 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 574.0455. LIST OF QUALIFIED TRANSPORTATION SERVICE
- 16 PROVIDERS. (a) The commissioners court of a county shall:
- 17 (1) establish and maintain a list of qualified
- 18 transportation service providers that a court may authorize or with
- 19 whom a person may contract to transport a person to a mental health
- 20 facility in accordance with Section 574.045;
- 21 (2) establish an application procedure for a person to
- 22 <u>be included on the list, including an appropriate application fee</u>
- 23 to be deposited in the county general fund;
- 24 (3) allow officers and employees of the county to
- 25 contract with persons on the list on a rotating basis if the officer
- 26 or employee is authorized to provide transportation under Section
- 27 574.045 and chooses to contract with a qualified transportation

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- 1 service provider; and
- 2 (4) ensure that the list is made available to any
- 3 person authorized to provide transportation under Section 574.045.
- 4 (b) The Department of State Health Services shall prescribe
- 5 uniform standards that a person must meet to be listed as a
- 6 qualified transportation service provider under Subsection (a).
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
