1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the imposition by certain municipalities and municipal  
1-9 transit departments of the local sales and use tax in certain  
1-10 federal military installations.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 321, Tax Code, is amended  
1-13 by adding Section 321.1045 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 321.1045. IMPOSITION OF SALES AND USE TAX IN CERTAIN  
1-15 FEDERAL MILITARY INSTALLATIONS. (a) This section applies only to a  
1-16 municipality with a population of more than 500,000 that borders  
1-17 the United Mexican States.

1-18 (b) For purposes of the sales and use tax imposed under this  
1-19 chapter, a reference in this chapter or other law to the  
1-20 municipality as the territory in which the tax or an incident of the  
1-21 tax applies includes the area within the boundaries of a federal  
1-22 military installation that is located in the municipality's  
1-23 extraterritorial jurisdiction.

1-24 (c) This section does not affect:

1-25 (1) the boundaries of an emergency services district  
1-26 that contains territory within the boundaries of a federal military  
1-27 installation on the effective date of this section;

1-28 (2) the authority of that emergency services district  
1-29 to continue to impose a sales and use tax in the entire territory of  
1-30 the district; or

1-31 (3) the duty of that emergency services district to  
1-32 provide services in the entire territory of the district.

1-33 SECTION 2. Section 453.051, Transportation Code, is amended  
1-34 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-35 (c) The jurisdiction of a transit department created by a  
1-36 municipality with a population of more than 500,000 that borders  
1-37 the United Mexican States does not include any territory within the  
1-38 boundaries of a federal military installation that is located in  
1-39 that municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 2011, if it  
1-41 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each  
1-42 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.  
1-43 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that  
1-44 date, this Act takes effect October 1, 2011.
