3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 204.061, Labor Code, is amended to read
5	as follows:
6	Sec. 204.061. CEILING AND FLOOR OF COMPENSATION FUND. $\underline{\text{(a)}}$
7	In this section, "covered wages" means taxable wages, divided by
8	\$9,000, multiplied by average weekly wages multiplied by 52 weeks.
9	(b) In computing the tax rates under this subchapter:
10	(1) the ceiling of the compensation fund is one-half
11	of one [two] percent of the total covered [taxable] wages for the
12	four calendar quarters ending the preceding June 30; and
13	(2) the floor of the compensation fund is equal to the
14	greater of:
15	(A) \$400 million; or

- 16 (B) one percent of the total taxable wages for
- 17 the four calendar quarters ending the preceding June 30.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
