5	SECTION 1. Section 211.002, Property Code, is amended by

- 8 (b) This chapter applies only to restrictions that affect 9 real property within a residential real estate subdivision or any 10 units or parcels of the subdivision and that, by the express terms 11 of the instrument creating the restrictions:
- 12 (1) are not subject to a procedure by which the 13 restrictions may be amended;  $[\frac{\partial \mathbf{r}}{\partial t}]$
- 14 (2) may not be amended without the unanimous consent 15 of:
- 16 (A) all property owners in the subdivision; or
- 17 (B) all property owners in any unit or parcel of the subdivision; or
- 19 (3) provide that amendments to the restrictions are
- 20 <u>not operative or effective until a specified date or the expiration</u>
- 21 of a specified period.
- 22 <u>(d) An amendment of a restriction under this chapter is</u>
- 23 effective on the filing of an instrument reflecting the amendment

- 4 (e) An amendment under this chapter of a restriction
- 5 described by Subsection (b)(3) is effective as provided by this
- 6 chapter, regardless of whether the date specified in the
- 7 restrictions has occurred or the period prescribed by the
- 8 restrictions has expired.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
