- 23 (b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.

- 3 SECTION 2. Section 13.036(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 (a) An appointment as a volunteer deputy registrar is
- 6 terminated on:
- 7 (1) the expiration of the volunteer deputy's term of
- 8 appointment; or
- 9 (2) the final conviction of the volunteer deputy for
- 10 an offense prescribed by Section $\underline{13.008}$ or $\underline{13.043}$.
