- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 542.4031(a), Transportation Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) In addition to the fine prescribed by Section 542.401 or
- 7 another section of this subtitle, as applicable, a person who
- 8 enters a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to or is convicted of an
- 9 offense under this subtitle shall pay $\frac{$45}{}$ [\$30] as a state traffic
- 10 fine. The person shall pay the state traffic fine when the person
- 11 enters the person's plea of guilty or nolo contendere, or on the
- 12 date of conviction, whichever is earlier. The state traffic fine
- 13 shall be paid regardless of whether:
- 14 (1) a sentence is imposed on the person;
- 15 (2) the court defers final disposition of the person's
- 16 case; or
- 17 (3) the person is placed on community supervision,
- 18 including deferred adjudication community supervision.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 22 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 23 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 24 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the

- 1 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 2 before that date.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
