5	SECTION 1. Title 3, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended by
6	adding Chapter 27 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 27. PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO PARKS IN THIS STATE
8	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
9	Sec. 27.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "political
10	subdivision" means a county, municipality, special district, river
11	authority, or other governmental entity created under the authority
12	of the state or a county or municipality.
13	Sec. 27.002. APPLICABILITY. Except as otherwise provided
14	by this chapter, this chapter applies to a land or water park that
15	is owned, operated, or maintained by this state or a political
16	subdivision of this state.

18	SUBCHAPTER B. PLAY AREAS IN PARKS
19	Sec. 27.021. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter
20	applies only to a park in which after December 31, 2011:

22	(2) at least 50 percent of a playground's equipment or
23	facilities are renovated.

- 4 (b) At least one element of the available play equipment in

- 7 Sec. 27.023. GUIDELINES TO ASSIST IN PARK DEVELOPMENT AND
- 8 MAINTENANCE. (a) The commission by rule may adopt guidelines
- 9 designed to assist an entity that develops or maintains a park in
- 10 the purchase, design, construction, or installation of
- 11 wheelchair-accessible surfaces and equipment.
- 12 <u>(b) Before adopting guidelines under this section, the</u>
- 13 commission must consult with the Department of Aging and Disability
- 14 Services or another qualified person for advice on surface
- 15 materials and the design, construction, and installation of
- 16 pathways and equipment that are appropriate for providing
- 17 wheelchair accessibility.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
