1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the designation of a portion of U.S. Highway 81 as the  
1-10 Corporal David Slaton Memorial Highway.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
1-13 is amended by adding Section 225.082 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 225.082. CORPORAL DAVID SLATON MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)  
1-15 The portion of U.S. Highway 81 from the Texas-Oklahoma border to the  
1-16 northern municipal boundary of Bowie is designated as the Corporal  
1-17 David Slaton Memorial Highway.

1-18 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-19 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
1-20 highway number, the designation as the Corporal David Slaton  
1-21 Memorial Highway, and any other appropriate information; and

1-22 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
1-23 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-24 (c) In this section, a reference to the municipal boundary  
1-25 of Bowie means that boundary as it exists on September 1, 2011.

1-26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-28 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-30 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
