A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the designation of property tax agents.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1.111, Tax Code, is amended by amending
- 5 Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (k) and (l) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (b) The designation of an agent must be made by written
- 8 authorization on a form prescribed by the comptroller under
- 9 Subsection (h) and signed by the owner, a property manager
- 10 authorized to designate agents for the owner, or another person
- 11 authorized to act on behalf of the owner other than the person being
- 12 designated as agent, and must clearly indicate that the person is
- 13 authorized to act on behalf of the property owner in property tax
- 14 matters relating to the property or the property owner. The
- 15 designation may authorize the agent to represent the owner in all
- 16 property tax matters or in specific property tax matters as
- 17 identified in the designation. The designation does not take
- 18 effect with respect to an appraisal district or a taxing unit
- 19 participating in the appraisal district until a copy of the
- 20 designation is filed with the appraisal district. Each appraisal
- 21 district established for a county having a population of 500,000 or
- 22 more shall implement a system that allows a designation to be signed
- 23 and filed electronically.
- 24 (k) On written request by the chief appraiser, an agent who

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- 1 electronically submits a designation of agent form shall provide
- 2 the chief appraiser information concerning:
- 3 (1) the electronic signature of the person who signed
- 4 the form;
- 5 (2) the date the person signed the form; and
- 6 (3) the Internet Protocol address of the computer the
- 7 person used to complete the form.
- 8 <u>(1) A person may not knowingly make a false entry in, or</u>
- 9 false alteration of, a designation of agent form that has been
- 10 signed as provided by Subsection (b).
- 11 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 12 to a designation of an agent that is made on or after the effective
- 13 date of this Act. A designation made before the effective date of
- 14 this Act is governed by the law in effect when the designation was
- 15 made, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
