1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the reporting requirements of a state agency that is
1-11 undergoing review by the Sunset Advisory Commission.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Chapter 325, Government Code, is amended by
1-14 adding Section 325.0075 to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 325.0075. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF AGENCY BEING
1-16 REVIEWED. Before September 1 of the odd-numbered year before the
1-17 year in which a state agency subject to this chapter is abolished,
1-18 the agency shall submit to the commission, the governor, the
1-19 lieutenant governor, and each member of the legislature a report
1-20 that:

1-21 (1) lists each report that the agency is required by a
1-22 statute to prepare; and

1-23 (2) evaluates the need for each report listed in
1-24 Subdivision (1) based on whether factors or conditions have changed
1-25 since the date the statutory requirement to prepare the report was
1-26 enacted.

1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-28 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-29 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-30 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
