| 7  | (a-1) This subsection applies to an election of a political          |
| 8  | subdivision other than a county. Notwithstanding Subsection (a),     |
| 9  | for an election of a political subdivision with a population of less |
| 10 | than 1,500, other than an election that is held jointly with another |
| 11 | election in which a federal office appears on the ballot, the        |
| 12 | political subdivision is not required to meet the requirements of    |
| 13 | Section 61.012(a)(1)(C) if the political subdivision:                |
| 14 | (1) allows for a reasonable accommodation for a voter                |
| 15 | with a disability in the manner provided by Subsection (b);          |
| 16 | (2) provides notice to the secretary of state in the                 |
| 17 | manner required under Subsection (d)(1); and                         |
| 18 | (3) includes in the notice of election:                              |
| 19 | (A) a statement that the election will not meet                      |
| 20 | the requirements for accessibility described by Section              |
| 21 | 61.012(a)(1)(C); and   |
| 22 | (B) a description of the process by which a voter                    |
| 23 | with a disability may request a reasonable accommodation to vote in  |
| 24 | the election.  |
