A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the expenditure of money from the general revenue fund
- 3 for rail projects.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 91.036, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 91.036. EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS. Subject to <u>Sections</u>
- 8 [Section] 91.071(b) and (c), the department may receive, accept,
- 9 and expend funds from this state, a federal agency, or other public
- 10 or private source for:
- 11 (1) rail planning;
- 12 (2) studies to determine the viability of a rail
- 13 facility for rail transportation service;
- 14 (3) studies to determine the necessity for the
- 15 department's acquisition or construction of a rail facility; and
- 16 (4) the acquisition, construction, maintenance, or
- 17 operation of a rail facility under this chapter, including the
- 18 assessment and remediation of environmental contamination existing
- 19 in or on a rail facility.
- SECTION 2. Section 91.071, Transportation Code, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- Sec. 91.071. FUNDING. (a) Subject to Subsections [Except
- 23 as provided in Subsection [(b) and (c), the department may use any
- 24 available funds to implement this chapter, including funds from the

- 1 state infrastructure bank.
- 2 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c) [for money received
- 3 from the Texas economic development bank fund under Section
- 4 489.102, Government Code], the department may not spend money from
- 5 the general revenue fund to implement this chapter except pursuant
- 6 to a line-item appropriation.
- 7 (c) The department may spend money from the general revenue
- 8 fund to implement this chapter without the need for a line-item
- 9 appropriation if the money is:
- 10 (1) received from the Texas economic development bank
- 11 fund under Section 489.102, Government Code; or
- 12 (2) appropriated to the Texas rail relocation and
- 13 improvement fund.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
