- 5 SECTION 1. Section 31.033, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) No person may display on a vessel a registration decal
- 8 that is altered, fraudulent, or issued under a certificate of
- 9 <u>number assigned to another vessel.</u>
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 31.043, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 11 amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
- 12 <u>(c-1) No person may intentionally sell, offer to sell, or</u>
- 13 purchase a vessel with a hull identification number, or an outboard
- 14 motor with a serial number, that has been altered, defaced,
- 15 mutilated, or removed.
- SECTION 3. Section 31.127(b), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (b) A person who violates Section 31.043(c) or 31.096 [of
- $19 \quad this \ code$ ] commits an offense that is a Class B Parks and Wildlife
- 20 Code misdemeanor. A person who violates Section 31.043(c-1)
- 21 commits an offense that is a Class A Parks and Wildlife Code
- 22 misdemeanor.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
