16	SECTION 3. Section 31.127(b), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	(b) A person who violates Section 31.043(c) or 31.096 [of
19	this code] commits an offense that is a Class B Parks and Wildlife
20	Code misdemeanor. <u>A person who violates Section 31.043(c-1)</u>
21	commits an offense that is a Class A Parks and Wildlife Code
22	misdemeanor.
23	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
