- 5 SECTION 1. Section 801.353, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (d-1) and (g) and amending Subsection (f) to

- 8 (d-1) The privilege provided by this section is waived by
- 9 the client or the owner of the animal treated by the veterinarian in
- 10 a proceeding to substantiate and collect on a debt incurred for
- 11 veterinary services.
- 12 (f) A veterinarian does not violate this section by
- 13 providing the name or address of a client, or the rabies vaccination
- 14 status of a specific client's specific animal, to a public health
- 15 authority, veterinarian, [or physician, or other licensed health
- 16 care professional who requests the identity of the client to obtain
- 17 information for:
- 18 (1) the verification of a rabies vaccination; [ex]
- 19 (2) other treatment involving a life-threatening
- 20 situation; or
- 21 (3) a public health purpose.
- 22 (g) A public health authority that receives information
- 23 under Subsection (f) shall maintain the confidentiality of the
- 24 information, may not disclose the information under Chapter 552,

- 2 does not directly relate to the protection of public health and
- 3 <u>safety.</u>
