(b) The governing body of a rural or urban transit district 17 by resolution may adopt rules for the safe and efficient operation 18 and maintenance of the transit district's transportation system, 19 except that the rules may not relate to Subchapter H, Chapter 411, 20 21 Government Code. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
