4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 27.017, Water Code, is amended to read as
6	follows:
7	Sec. 27.017. RECOMMENDATIONS FROM OTHER ENTITIES. (a) The
8	executive director shall submit to the [Texas] Department of <u>State</u>
9	Health <u>Services</u> and to other persons which the commission may
10	designate copies of every application received in proper form.
11	These entities may make recommendations to the commission
12	concerning any aspect of the application within 30 days.
13	(b) If an application is received in proper form for a
14	permit for an injection well to dispose of industrial and municipal
15	waste and the proposed location of the injection well is in the
16	territory of a groundwater conservation district, the executive
17	director shall submit a copy of the application to the governing
18	body of the groundwater conservation district.
19	SECTION 2. Section 27.018, Water Code, is amended by adding
20	Subsection (e) to read as follows:
21	(e) In addition to the requirements of Subsection (c),
22	before any testimony is heard in a contested case regarding an
23	application for a permit for an injection well to dispose of
24	industrial and municipal waste that is proposed to be located in the

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1 territory of a groundwater conservation district, the record of the 2 proceeding must include evidence that:

3 (1) a copy of each draft permit proposed by the 4 executive director was provided to the governing body of the 5 groundwater conservation district; and

6 (2) notice of the contested case hearing was mailed to
7 the governing body of the groundwater conservation district.

8 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only in 9 regard to the provision of copies of and proceedings on an 10 application for a permit for an injection well to dispose of 11 industrial and municipal waste that is proposed to be located in the 12 territory of a groundwater conservation district that is received 13 in proper form by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on 14 or after the effective date of this Act.

15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
