1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the creation of a Don't Mess with Texas Water program to
1-9 prevent illegal dumping that affects the surface waters of this
1-10 state.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 26, Water Code, is amended
1-13 by adding Section 26.053 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 26.053. DON'T MESS WITH TEXAS WATER PROGRAM. (a) The
1-15 commission by rule shall establish a program to prevent illegal
1-16 dumping that affects the surface waters of this state by placing
1-17 signs on major highway water crossings that notify drivers of a
1-18 toll-free number to call to report illegal dumping.

1-19 (b) The commission shall establish a toll-free number
1-20 hotline that will forward calls to the appropriate law enforcement
1-21 agency.

1-22 (c) A local government may work with the commission to
1-23 participate in the program. A local government that participates
1-24 in the program may contribute to the cost of operating the toll-free
1-25 number hotline.

1-26 (d) The Texas Department of Transportation shall cooperate
1-27 with the commission in the placement of signs described by
1-28 Subsection (a).

1-29 (e) The Texas Department of Transportation shall post a sign
1-30 that complies with program requirements at a major highway water
1-31 crossing at the time a previously posted sign identifying the
1-32 crossing or prohibiting dumping at the crossing is scheduled to be
1-33 replaced.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
