5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 51.976 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 51.976. TEMPORARY HOUSING BETWEEN ACADEMIC TERMS FOR
9	CERTAIN STUDENTS FORMERLY UNDER CONSERVATORSHIP OF DEPARTMENT OF
10	FAMILY AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES. (a) In this section:

- (1) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning 11
- 12 assigned by Section 61.003.
- (2) "Academic term" includes a summer session. 13
- (b) To be eligible to receive housing assistance from an 14
- institution of higher education under Subsection (c), a student 15
- 16 must:
- 17 (1) have been under the conservatorship of the
- Department of Family and Protective Services or its predecessor in 18
- function on the day preceding: 19
- 20 (A) the student's 18th birthday; or
- (B) the date the student's disabilities of 21
- minority are removed by a court under Chapter 31, Family Code; 22
- (2) be enrolled full-time at the institution during 23
- the academic term immediately preceding the period for which the 24

- 1 student requests the housing assistance;
- 2 (3) be registered or otherwise have taken the actions
- 3 required by the institution to permit the student to enroll
- 4 full-time at the institution during the academic term immediately
- 5 following the period for which the student requests the housing
- 6 assistance; and
- 7 (4) lack other reasonable temporary housing
- 8 alternatives between the academic terms described by Subdivisions
- 9 (2) and (3), as determined by the institution.
- 10 (c) On the student's request, each institution of higher
- 11 education shall assist an eligible student in locating temporary
- 12 housing for any period beginning on the last day of an academic term
- 13 and ending on the first day of the immediately following academic
- 14 term, according to the institution's academic calendar.
- 15 (d) For each eligible student under Subsection (b) who also
- 16 demonstrates financial need, the institution may:
- 17 (1) provide a stipend to cover any reasonable costs of
- 18 the temporary housing that are not covered by other financial aid
- 19 immediately available to the student for that purpose; or
- 20 (2) provide temporary housing directly to the student
- 21 for the applicable period.
- (e) The receipt of a stipend under Subsection (d) does not
- 23 prohibit the student from receiving additional stipends under that
- 24 subsection in one or more subsequent periods, based on the
- 25 student's demonstrated financial need.
- 26 (f) An institution of higher education may use any available
- 27 revenue, including legislative appropriations, and may solicit and

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- 1 accept gifts, grants, and donations for the purposes of this
- 2 section. The institution shall use any gifts, grants, and
- 3 donations received for the purposes of this section before using
- 4 other revenue.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
