2	relating to temporary housing between academic terms for certain
3	postsecondary students who have been under the conservatorship of
4	the Department of Family and Protective Services.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 51.976 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 51.976. TEMPORARY HOUSING BETWEEN ACADEMIC TERMS FOR
9	STUDENTS FORMERLY UNDER CONSERVATORSHIP OF DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND

- PROTECTIVE SERVICES. (a) In this section: 10
- 11 (1) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning 12 assigned by Section 61.003.
- 13 (2) "Academic term" includes a summer session.
- 14 (b) To be eligible to receive housing assistance from an
- institution of higher education under Subsection (c), a student 15
- 16 must:
- (1) at any time before the student's 18th birthday, 17
- 18 have been under the conservatorship of the Department of Family and
- Protective Services or its predecessor in function; 19
- (2) be enrolled full-time at the institution during 20
- 21 the academic term immediately preceding the period for which the
- student requests the housing assistance; 22
- (3) be registered or otherwise have taken the actions 23
- required by the institution to permit the student to enroll 24

- 1 full-time at the institution during the academic term immediately
- 2 following the period for which the student requests the housing
- 3 assistance; and
- 4 (4) lack other reasonable temporary housing
- 5 alternatives between the academic terms described by Subdivisions
- 6 (2) and (3), as determined by the institution.
- 7 (c) On the student's request, each institution of higher
- 8 education shall assist an eligible student in locating temporary
- 9 housing for any period beginning on the last day of an academic term
- 10 and ending on the first day of the immediately following academic
- 11 term, according to the institution's academic calendar.
- 12 (d) For each eligible student under Subsection (b) who also
- 13 demonstrates financial need, the institution may:
- 14 (1) provide a stipend to cover any reasonable costs of
- 15 the temporary housing that are not covered by other financial aid
- 16 <u>immediately available to the student for that purpose; or</u>
- 17 (2) provide temporary housing directly to the student
- 18 for the applicable period.
- 19 (e) The receipt of a stipend under Subsection (d) does not
- 20 prohibit the student from receiving additional stipends under that
- 21 subsection in one or more subsequent periods, based on the
- 22 <u>student's demonstrated financial need.</u>
- 23 (f) An institution of higher education may use any available
- 24 revenue, including legislative appropriations, and may solicit and
- 25 accept gifts, grants, and donations for the purposes of this
- 26 <u>section</u>. The institution shall use any gifts, grants, and
- 27 donations received for the purposes of this section before using

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1 other revenue.

- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
