 18 (b) Notwithstanding Section 54.0513 or another law
- 19 authorizing an institution of higher education to establish tuition
- 20 rates, the total amount of tuition charged by a general academic
- 21 teaching institution to a student for the 2011-2012 or 2012-2013
- 22 <u>academic year may not exceed the total amount of tuition that the</u>
- 23 institution would have charged under this chapter to a similarly
- 24 situated student for the 2010-2011 academic year.

- 1 (c) For purposes of this section, students are similarly
- 2 situated if they share the same residency status, degree program,
- 3 course load, course level, tuition exemption status, and other
- 4 circumstances affecting the tuition charged to the student.
- 5 (d) This section does not ensure that the total amount of
- 6 tuition charged to an individual student does not increase based on
- 7 a change in the student's residency status, degree program, course
- 8 load, course level, tuition exemption status, or other circumstance
- 9 affecting the tuition charged to the student.
- 10 (e) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board may adopt
- 11 rules as necessary to administer this section.
- 12 (f) This section expires August 31, 2013.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
