- 3 Sec. 521.181. ISSUANCE OF DRIVER'S LICENSE. (a) On

- 6 applicant has applied.

considers appropriate;
(F) the person's signature;
(G) each class of commercial motor vehicle that
the person is authorized to drive, with any endorsements or
restrictions;
(H) the name of this state; and
(I) the dates between which the license is valid.
(b) Except as provided by this subchapter, each commercial
driver's license issued by the department:
(1) must:
(A) be in the same format;
(B) have the same appearance and orientation; and
(C) contain the same type of information; and
(2) may not include any information that this chapter
does not reference or require.
SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
a driver's license, commercial driver's license, or personal
identification certificate issued on or after the effective date of
this Act. A driver's license, commercial driver's license, or
personal identification certificate issued before the effective
date of this Act is subject to the law in effect on the date of
issuance, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
