## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating to the exemption from ad valorem taxation of the residence
3	homestead of the surviving spouse of a 100 percent or totally
4	disabled veteran.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 6 SECTION 1. Section 11.131, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- Subsection (c) to read as follows: 7
- (c) The surviving spouse of a disabled veteran who qualified 8
- 9 for an exemption under Subsection (b) is entitled to an exemption
- from taxation of the total appraised value of the same property to 10
- which the disabled veteran's exemption applied if: 11
- 12 (1) the surviving spouse has not remarried since the
- death of the disabled veteran; and 13
- 14 (2) the property:
- (A) was the residence homestead of the surviving 15
- 16 spouse when the disabled veteran died; and
- (B) remains the residence homestead of the 17
- 18 surviving spouse.
- SECTION 2. Section 11.431(a), Tax Code, is amended to read 19
- 20 as follows:

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- 21 The chief appraiser shall accept and approve or deny an
- 22 application for a residence homestead exemption, including an [a
- 23 disabled veteran residence homestead] exemption under Section
- 11.131 for the residence homestead of a disabled veteran or the 24

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- 1 <u>surviving spouse of a disabled veteran</u>, after the deadline for
- 2 filing it has passed if it is filed not later than one year after the
- 3 delinquency date for the taxes on the homestead.
- 4 SECTION 3. Section 11.131, Tax Code, as amended by this Act,
- 5 applies only to a tax year beginning on or after January 1, 2012.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 2012, but only
- 7 if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 82nd Legislature,
- 8 Regular Session, 2011, authorizing the legislature to exempt from
- 9 ad valorem taxation the residence homestead of the surviving spouse
- 10 of a 100 percent or totally disabled veteran in an amount equal to
- 11 the amount of the residence homestead exemption to which the
- 12 disabled veteran was entitled on the same property is approved by
- 13 the voters. If that amendment is not approved by the voters, this
- 14 Act has no effect.
