- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 9, Family Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 9.0125 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 9.0125. REQUIREMENTS FOR ENFORCEMENT BY CONTEMPT.
- 8 Before a court may render an order in a proceeding under this title
- 9 that includes enforcement by contempt, the court must find that the
- 10 provisions of the order for which enforcement is requested are
- 11 clear, specific, and unambiguous.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 157, Family Code, is
- 13 amended by adding Section 157.1655 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 157.1655. REQUIREMENTS FOR ENFORCEMENT BY CONTEMPT.
- 15 Before a court may render an order in a proceeding under this title
- 16 that includes enforcement by contempt, the court must find that the
- 17 provisions of the order for which enforcement is requested are
- 18 clear, specific, and unambiguous.
- 19 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to a proceeding to enforce an order that is commenced on or after
- 21 the effective date of this Act. A proceeding to enforce commenced
- 22 before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 23 proceeding was commenced, and the former law is continued in effect
- 24 for that purpose.
