## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 264.101(a-2), Family Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a-2) The department shall continue to pay the cost of
- 7 foster care under:
- 8 (1) Subsection (a-1)(1) until:
- 9 (A) the last day of the third full month after the
- 10 date the child receives a high school diploma or high school
- 11 equivalency certificate; or
- 12 <u>(B)</u> the last day of the month in which the child
- 13 attains the age of 22 <u>if the child has not received a high school</u>
- 14 diploma or high school equivalency certificate; and
- 15 (2) Subsections (a-1)(2)-(5) until the last day of the
- 16 month the child attains the age of 21.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to
- 18 foster care payments for a child who is in foster care on or after
- 19 the effective date of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
