- 8 If a school district located wholly or partly in a county with a
- 9 population of one million or more maintains an Internet website,
- 10 the district, instead of meeting the publication requirements under
- 11 Section 44.031(g), may:
- 12 (1) publish notice in a newspaper described by Section
- 13 44.031(g) once not later than the 14th day before the bid receipt
- 14 deadline; and
- 15 (2) post notice continuously on the district website,
- 16 with a conspicuous link to the notice on the site's home page, for
- 17 at least 14 days immediately preceding the bid receipt deadline.
- 18 (b) The newspaper notice under Subsection (a) must include
- 19 the time and place at which the bids will be publicly opened and the
- 20 Internet website address for the procurement information.
- 21 (c) The board of trustees of a school district shall
- 22 publicly adopt standards to ensure that Internet posting of notice

- 10 (2) post notice continuously on the municipal website,
- 11 with a conspicuous link to the notice on the site's home page, for
- 12 at least 14 days immediately preceding the bid receipt deadline.
- 13 (b) The newspaper notice under Subsection (a) must include
- 14 the time and place at which the bids will be publicly opened and the
- 15 Internet website address for the procurement information.
- 16 (c) The governing body of a municipality shall publicly

- 13 If a governmental entity located wholly or partly in a county with a
- 14 population of one million or more maintains an Internet website,
- 15 the entity, instead of meeting the publication requirements under
- 16 <u>Section 271.025(b)</u>, may:
- 17 (1) publish notice in a newspaper described by Section
- 18 271.025(b) once not later than the 14th day before the bid receipt
- 19 deadline; and
- 20 (2) post notice continuously on the entity's website,
- 21 with a conspicuous link to the notice on the site's home page, for
- 22 <u>at least 14 days immediately preceding the bid receipt deadline.</u>
- (b) The newspaper notice under Subsection (a) must include
- 24 the time and place at which the bids will be publicly opened and the
- 25 Internet website address for the procurement information.
- 26 <u>(c) The governing body of the governmental entity shall</u>
- 27 publicly adopt standards to ensure that Internet posting of notice

- 2 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 3 a notice required to be provided on or after September 1, 2011. A
- 4 notice required to be provided before September 1, 2011, is
- 5 governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and that
- 6 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
