A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to an exemption from the motor vehicle use tax for motor
- 3 vehicles brought into this state by military service members
- 4 serving on active duty.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 152.022, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 7 Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 8 (c) The tax imposed by this section does not apply to a motor
- 9 vehicle purchased at retail sale outside this state and used on the
- 10 public highways of this state by an active duty member of the United
- 11 States armed forces residing in this state on military orders.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 152.023, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 13 Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 14 (d) The tax imposed by this section does not apply to a motor
- 15 vehicle described by Subsection (a) that is brought into this state
- 16 by an active duty member of the United States armed forces residing
- 17 in this state on military orders.
- 18 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 19 affect taxes imposed before the effective date of this Act, and the
- 20 law in effect immediately before that date is continued in effect
- 21 for purposes of the liability for and collection of those taxes.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 2011, if it
- 23 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 24 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.

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- 1 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that
- 2 date, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
