- 4 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter A, Chapter 1, Family
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 SUBCHAPTER A. DEFINITIONS AND GENERAL PROVISIONS
- 7 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 1, Family Code, is amended
- 8 by adding Section 1.004 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 1.004. REQUEST FOR ATTORNEY'S FEES. If attorney's fees
- 10 are sought in a proceeding under this title in connection with more
- 11 than one claim or statutory basis for recovery of attorney's fees,
- 12 the request for fees must disaggregate the total amount sought by
- 13 claim or basis for recovery so that the amount sought for each claim
- 14 or basis of recovery is specifically identified.
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 81.005, Family Code, is amended by
- 16 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 17 (c) If attorney's fees are sought in a proceeding under this
- 18 title in connection with more than one claim or statutory basis for
- 19 recovery of attorney's fees, the request for fees must disaggregate
- 20 the total amount sought by claim or basis for recovery so that the
- 21 amount sought for each claim or basis of recovery is specifically
- 22 identified.
- SECTION 4. Section 106.002, Family Code, is amended by
- 24 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

- 1 (c) If attorney's fees are sought in connection with more
- 2 than one claim or statutory basis for recovery of attorney's fees,
- 3 the request for fees must disaggregate the total amount sought by
- 4 claim or basis for recovery so that the amount sought for each claim

- 6 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 7 request for attorney's fees made on or after the effective date of
- 8 this Act. A request for attorney's fees made before the effective
- 9 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 10 request is made, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 11 purpose.
- 12 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
