- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 46.004(b) and (c), Parks and Wildlife
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The commission may establish a lower fee or waive the
- 8 fee or license requirement for:
- 9 (1) a resident who has a general commercial
- 10 fisherman's license of this state;
- 11 (2) a resident who is blind as defined by Section
- 12 94.001, Human Resources Code;
- 13 (3) a resident or nonresident who is under 17 years
- 14 old; or
- 15 (4) a [resident or] nonresident who is 65 years old or
- 16 over.
- 17 (c) The commission shall waive the fee for:
- 18 <u>(1)</u> a qualified disabled veteran as defined by Section
- 19 42.012<u>;</u>
- 20 (2) [and for] a resident on active duty as a member of
- 21 the United States military forces, the Texas Army National Guard,
- 22 the Texas Air National Guard, or the Texas State Guard; and
- 23 (3) a resident who is 65 years old or over.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
