## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to reportable boating accidents and the penalties for
- 3 certain boating accidents.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 31.105(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The operator of a vessel involved in a collision,
- 8 accident, or other casualty that results in death or injury to a
- 9 person or damage to property in excess of an amount set by the
- 10 commission of not less than \$2,000 [\$500] shall report to [file
- 11 with] the department on or before the expiration of 30 days after
- 12 the incident a full description of the collision, accident, or
- 13 casualty in accordance with regulations established by the
- 14 department.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 31.132, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 31.132. REPORTING PROCEDURES FOR ENFORCEMENT
- 18 OFFICERS. A marine safety enforcement officer shall provide to the
- 19 department on a form prescribed by the department a report of any
- 20 incident the officer investigates that involves a boating accident,
- 21 water fatality, or person who allegedly operates a boat while
- 22 intoxicated. The officer shall provide the report not later than
- 23 the 15th day after the date the officer initially became aware of
- 24 the incident [occurred].

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 24(g), Water Safety Act (Article 9206,
- 2 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), as added by Section 1, Chapter 48
- 3 (H.B. 146), Acts of the 64th Legislature, Regular Session, 1975, is
- 4 repealed.
- 5 SECTION 4. (a) The Parks and Wildlife Commission shall
- 6 adopt rules required to implement Section 31.105(a), Parks and
- 7 Wildlife Code, as amended by this Act, not later than December 1,
- 8 2011.
- 9 (b) Section 31.105(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, as amended
- 10 by this Act, applies only to a report for an accident that occurs on
- 11 or after January 1, 2012. A report for an accident that occurs
- 12 before January 1, 2012, is governed by the law in effect at the time
- 13 of the accident, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 14 purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
