- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 455.001, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subdivision (9-a) to read as follows:
- 8 (9-a) "Muscle activation techniques" means the
- 9 identification and correction of muscular imbalances through
- 10 palpation and isometric exercises.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 455.004, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- Sec. 455.004. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. This chapter does
- 14 not apply to:
- 15 (1) a person licensed in this state as a physician,
- 16 chiropractor, occupational therapist, physical therapist, nurse,
- 17 cosmetologist, or athletic trainer or as a member of a similar
- 18 profession subject to state licensing while the person is
- 19 practicing within the scope of the license;
- 20 (2) a school approved by the Texas Education Agency or
- 21 otherwise approved by the state; [or]
- 22 (3) an instructor otherwise approved by the state to
- 23 teach in an area of study included in the required course of
- 24 instruction for issuance of a massage therapist license; or

- 1 (4) a person who, for compensation, employs muscle
- 2 <u>activation techniques</u>.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
