Chapter 209, Property Code, is amended by adding 5 Section 209.0091 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 209.0091. JUDICIAL FORECLOSURE REQUIRED. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a property owners' association may 8 9 not foreclose a property owners' association assessment lien unless the association first obtains a court order in an application for 10 expedited foreclosure under the rules adopted by the supreme court 11 under Subsection (b). 12 (b) The supreme court, as an exercise of the court's 13 14 authority under Section 74.024, Government Code, shall adopt rules establishing expedited foreclosure proceedings for use by a 15 16 property owners' association in foreclosing an assessment lien of the association. Except as provided by this section, the rules 17 adopted under this subsection must be substantially similar to the 18 19 rules adopted by the supreme court under Section 50(r), Article XVI, T<u>exas Constitution.</u> 20 21 (c) Rules adopted under Subsection (b) must require service on the record owners of the property of a copy of the notice and 22 23 application for foreclosure of the lien by the same methods of

24 service prescribed for service of citation under Rules 106 through

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1 <u>119, Texas Rules of Civil Procedure.</u>

2 (d) Expedited foreclosure is not required under this
3 section if the owner of the property that is subject to foreclosure
4 agrees in writing at the time the foreclosure is sought to waive
5 expedited foreclosure under this section. A waiver under this
6 subsection may not be required as a condition of the transfer of
7 title to real property.

8 SECTION 2. (a) Section 209.0091, Property Code, as added 9 by this Act, applies only to a foreclosure sale that occurs after 10 January 1, 2012. A foreclosure sale that occurs on or before 11 January 1, 2012, is governed by the law in effect immediately before 12 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect 13 for that purpose.

14 (b) Not later than January 1, 2012, the Supreme Court of
15 Texas shall adopt rules of civil procedure under Section 209.0091,
16 Property Code, as added by this Act.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
