4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 708, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 708.159 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 708.159. ADVANCE PAYMENT OF SURCHARGES. (a) The
8	department shall offer an option for a single up-front payment to a
9	person who is assessed an annual surcharge under this chapter to
10	allow the person to pay in advance the total amount that will be
11	owed for the 36-month period for which the surcharge will be
12	assessed.
13	(b) Notice under Section 708.151 of an initial surcharge
14	imposed under this chapter must notify the driver's license holder
15	of:
16	(1) the total amount the person will owe for the
17	36-month period for which the surcharge will be assessed; and
18	(2) the availability of the advance payment option
19	under this section.
20	(c) If a person makes a single up-front payment under this
21	section in the amount specified in the notice under Subsection
22	(b)(1) and the person is not, in the 36-month period for which the

person made the up-front payment, subsequently convicted of an

offense requiring a surcharge or an increase in the amount due to

- 1 the department, the department is not required to:
- 2 (1) take any further action under Section 708.053,
- 3 <u>708.102, 708.103, or 708.104, as applicable; or</u>
- 4 (2) annually notify the person of the assessment of
- 5 the surcharge under Section 708.151.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 708.159, Transportation Code, as added
- 7 by this Act, applies to any total surcharge amounts owed by a person
- 8 for a 36-month period under Chapter 708, Transportation Code,
- 9 regardless of whether the initial annual surcharge was assessed
- 10 before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
