1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to naming a segment of Interstate Highway 10 in Kendall
1-10 County the Trooper Kurt David Knapp Memorial Highway.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
1-13 is amended by adding Section 225.083 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 225.083. TROOPER KURT DAVID KNAPP MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

1-15 (a) The portion of Interstate Highway 10 in Kendall County
1-16 beginning with mile marker 522 and ending at mile marker 535 is
1-17 designated as the Trooper Kurt David Knapp Memorial Highway.

1-18 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-19 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
1-20 highway number, the designation as the Trooper Kurt David Knapp
1-21 Memorial Highway, and any other appropriate information; and

1-22 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
1-23 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
