(a) The portion of Interstate Highway 10 in Kendall County beginning with mile marker 522 and ending at mile marker 535 is 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 1-17 designated as the Trooper Kurt David Knapp Memorial Highway. (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall: 1-18 (1) design and construct markers indicating highway number, the designation as the Trooper Kurt David Ki Memorial Highway, and any other appropriate information; and 1-19 1-20 1-21 Knapp 1-22 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at 1-23 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway. 1-24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-25 ī**-**26 1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
