A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to offenses involving operating a motorboat in a circular 3 course. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the Britteny Sage Lindt Act. 6 7 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 31.099, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows: 8 Sec. 31.099. PROHIBITION ON CIRCULAR COURSE 9 AROUND INDIVIDUALS ENGAGED IN WATER ACTIVITIES [FISHERMAN OR SWIMMER]. 10 SECTION 3. Section 31.099, Parks and Wildlife Code, is 11 12 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows: 13 14 (a) No person may operate a motorboat in a circular course around: 15 (1) any other boat or personal watercraft any occupant 16 of which is engaged in fishing, waterskiing, or a similar activity; 17 18 or (2) [around] any person swimming. 19 20 (a-1) Subsection (a) does not apply to a person operating a 21 motorboat in a circular course to retrieve a downed or fallen water-skier or other person engaged in a similar activity. 22 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only 23 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 24

1 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 2 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the 3 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 4 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 5 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that 6 date.

7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
