- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 31.099, Parks and
- 6 Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 31.099. PROHIBITION ON CIRCULAR COURSE AROUND
- 8 INDIVIDUALS ENGAGED IN WATER ACTIVITIES [FISHERMAN OR SWIMMER].
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 31.099, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 10 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (a) No person may operate a motorboat in a circular course
- 13 around<u>:</u>
- 14 (1) any other boat or personal watercraft any occupant
- 15 of which is engaged in fishing, waterskiing, or a similar activity;
- 16 or
- 17 <u>(2)</u> [around] any person swimming.
- 18 <u>(a-1)</u> Subsection (a) does not apply to a person operating a
- 19 motorboat in a circular course to retrieve a downed or fallen
- 20 water-skier or other person engaged in a similar activity.
- 21 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 23 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 24 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the

- 1 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 2 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 3 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that
- 4 date.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
