## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to circumstances involving extrinsic fraud in

- 3 establishment of paternity.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 160, Family Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 160.107 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 160.107. PATERNITY ORDER BASED ON EXTRINSIC FRAUD. A
- 8 person identified in a court order as the father of a child who
- 9 demonstrates that the order was obtained by fraudulent
- 10 representations made by the child's mother to induce the person
- 11 into believing that the person was the child's father satisfies any
- 12 requirement in law that the person demonstrate the existence of
- 13 <u>extrinsic fraud in order to be entitled to equitable relief from the</u>
- 14 order through a bill of review or other judicial action.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 160.107, Family Code, as added by this
- 16 Act, applies to any order identifying a person as the father of a
- 17 child, regardless of the date on which the order was rendered.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
