The issues at a hearing 9 under this subchapter are whether: 10 11 (1) [reasonable suspicion or probable cause existed to 12 stop or arrest the person; [(2) probable cause existed to believe that] the 13 person was: 14 (A) operating a motor vehicle in a public place 15 [while intoxicated]; or 16 operating a watercraft powered with an engine 17 (B) having a manufacturer's rating of 50 horsepower or above [while 18 intoxicated]; 19 (2) [(3)] the person was placed under arrest [by the 20 21 officer] and was requested by a peace officer to submit to the taking of a specimen; and 22 (3) [(4)] the person refused to submit to the taking 23 24 of a specimen on request of the officer.
