- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 228.004, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 228.004. [PROMOTION OF] TOLL PROJECT INFORMATION. (a)
- 8 The department may, notwithstanding Chapter 2113, Government Code:
- 9 (1) $[\tau]$ engage in marketing, advertising, and other
- 10 activities to provide information relating to:
- 11 (A) the status of pending or ongoing [promote the
- 12 development and use of | toll projects; or
- 13 (B) the use and availability of toll tags or
- 14 other toll-related resources available to the public; and
- 15 (2) [may] enter into contracts or agreements necessary
- 16 to procure marketing, advertising, or <u>informational</u> [other
- 17 promotional] services from outside service providers to provide the
- 18 information described by Subdivision (1).
- 19 (b) This section does not authorize the department to engage
- 20 in marketing, advertising, or other activities for the purpose of
- 21 influencing public opinion about the use of toll roads or the use of
- 22 tolls as a financial mechanism or promoting or advocating for the
- 23 benefits of toll roads.
- 24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

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- 1 to a contract or agreement entered into or renewed under Section
- 2 228.004, Transportation Code, on or after the effective date of
- 3 this Act. A contract or agreement entered into or renewed under
- 4 that section before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 5 the law in effect immediately before that date, and that law is
- 6 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
