- 4 SECTION 1. Section 644.054(b), Transportation Code, is

- 6 (b) The department shall adopt rules regulating the
- 7 operation of a contract carrier to which this section applies. The
- 8 rules must:
- 9 (1) prohibit a person from operating a vehicle for
- 10 more than 12 hours in a day;
- 11 (2) require a person who operates a vehicle for the
- 12 number of consecutive hours or days the department determines is
- 13 excessive to rest for a period determined by the department;
- 14 (3) require a contract carrier to keep a record of all
- 15 hours a vehicle subject to regulation under this section is
- 16 operated;
- 17 (4) require a contract carrier to perform alcohol and
- 18 drug testing of vehicle operators on employment, on suspicion of
- 19 alcohol or drug abuse, and periodically as determined by the
- 20 department;
- 21 (5) require a contract carrier, at a minimum, to
- 22 maintain for each vehicle:
- 23 (A) liability insurance in the amount of \$3
- 24 [\$1.5] million [for each vehicle]; and

- 1 (B) uninsured or underinsured motorist coverage
- 2 in the amount of \$300,000; and
- 3 (6) be determined by the department to be necessary to
- 4 protect the safety of a passenger being transported or the general
- 5 public.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
