- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 33.901, Education Code, is amended to

- 6 Sec. 33.901. BREAKFAST PROGRAMS. (a) If at least 10
- 7 percent of the students enrolled in one or more schools in a school
- 8 district or enrolled in an open-enrollment charter school are
- 9 eligible for free or reduced-price breakfasts under the national
- 10 school breakfast program provided for by the Child Nutrition Act of
- 11 1966 (42 U.S.C. Section 1773), the governing body of the district or
- 12 the open-enrollment charter school shall participate in the program
- 13 and make the benefits of the program available to all eligible
- 14 students in the schools or school.
- 15 (b) A school district campus or an open-enrollment charter
- 16 school participating in the national school breakfast program
- 17 provided by the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. Section 1773)
- 18 in which 80 percent or more of the students qualify for a free or
- 19 reduced-price breakfast shall provide a free breakfast to each
- 20 <u>student during school hours.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 22 school year.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
